- be able to manage classrooms through creating and maintaining learner interest
- have learned how to reflect upon learning and teaching issues
- be able to put into use reflection for professional development
- be able to apply all the teaching knowledge into practice in real classrooms
- be able to teach lessons with minimal guidance
